



## Misión Rules for Guests

Welcome to our humble home. Your visit with us is a treasure and blessing to the ministry and we pray that God blesses you while you stay with us. If there is anything you need during your visit, please feel free to ask. Below are a few guidelines for your stay.

1. Please leave the door keys in your door and keep your door shut to prevent mosquitoes from entering.
2. Please do not eat food in your rooms to prevent bugs and mice from finding food left lying around. You may eat in the dining hall, on the porches, patio and in the yard.
3. Please store your bags under your beds and assure that they are kept closed and zipped to prevent critters from entering them. Rooms are fumigated before every group's visit and afterwards too.
4. Please sweep daily and keep your rooms tidy. This is not our staff's job. They clean before and after your visit. We will do room inspections because ants, rats, spiders and scorpions are a constant problem.
5. Please put all burnable trash in blue trash bin and keep it covered so the dogs don't distribute trash around the yard. Please put non-burnable trash in the white bucket next to the blue bin. With teams, there is much more trash to burn, please help us with this extra work.
6. Please do not flush toilet paper or any other items in the toilets. There are trash bins in each bathroom for this. If the trash is full, please deliver the bag to the trash bin and put a new bag in the bathroom bin.
7. Please conserve water, use as little as possible and help us monitor filling the pilas when there is water in the pipes.
8. If there is a problem with toilets, outlets, lights, fans, or anything then please inform us right away.
9. Please obtain your meals at the kitchen (our workers do not serve you at the table) and clean up your table after eating.
10. Do not put food or beverage bottles in the mission kitchen refrigerator, space is limited. We will provide a cooler in which you can store drinks. Do not drink the bags of water in this cooler as they are your ice to keep drinks cold. Each night before bed please put your ice in the freezer and recover it in the morning.
